2021 TOEIC I Course Outline

Course Description

This course is designed to help students develop techniques/ strategies for the TOEIC test. Emphasis will be on providing sample practice in preparing for the tasks and types of questions used on the test. This course is particularly useful for those who are unfamiliar with the content and structure of the test. Students are required to take the TOEIC test once a year. Target score: 650 or more.

Learning Outcomes

Students will be familiar with the TOEIC test format, instructions and questions types. Students will understand how to better manage their time under exam conditions. Students will be able to quickly and accurately process information. Students will learn strategies for answer selection. Students will be familiar with the different accents in English.

Course Content

Listening (Photographs/Questions-Response/Short Conversations/Short Talks) Reading (Incomplete Sentences/Text Completion/Reading Comprehension)

Grading Criteria

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| Word Test | 10% |
| Summer/Winter homework | 20% |
| Term Test(1 st term)/TOEIC Score | 50% |

Students are required to take the TOEIC test once a year. Students who do not take the test will not receive credit for the course.
