

Second Year World Affairs Course Outline 2021-2022

Course Description

This course is designed to introduce students to a wide range of contemporary issues. Students will develop their conversation, comprehension, discussion, and presentation skills. Pair and group work will be used so that students can give their opinions on the personal, social, and global issues covered in class. The textbook and other materials should be used to introduce the topics. Students will also make group presentations.
