Course Description

This course will take students to the next level of English writing, and build upon what they learned in the first year writing course.

Students will learn how to structure and write effective paragraphs and essays in English, and students will learn how to express themselves in English in a more idiomatic manner.

- Students will learn how to write grammatically more advanced sentences in English.
- Students will learn how to turn paragraphs into effective essays in English.
- Students will learn how to effectively edit their own writing and that of their peers.
- Students will learn how to answer short essay questions.
