Outline	This course is designed for advanced-level students and will be led by a native English teacher. The main focus will revolve around a selection of musical genres and eras, exploring notable artists, lyrics, and the societal contexts of their time. While the course primarily consists of lectures, there will also be opportunities for students to engage in discussions on related topics. Additionally, students will be encouraged to share their musical preferences and interests, and sometimes we will sing English songs in class so students can further immerse themselves in the music.
Teaching Methods	The year will be divided into five separate genres or eras of music. Each session will begin with informative lectures on our weekly topics, followed by engaging discussions related to the topics of the class, and occasional singing of songs by students willing to do so. Classes will also incorporate multimedia resources and delve into song lyrics and the social histories of the time. Students will have opportunities to share their own musical interests, but are under no obligation to give individual presentations to the class.
Textbook	Handouts will be supplied by the teacher. (No textbook)
Student Level	This will be a challenging class, aimed at students of an advanced level. It is expected that students will be willing and able to participate in discussions and other activities during each class. Students should also be willing to ask questions as much as required.
