Outline	Newspaper English is a class that supports students to read an English newspaper. The aim is to improve comprehension, vocabulary and grammar, to expand knowledge of world events/issues and to explore and understand differing perspectives.
	This course is designed to develop English language skills through the exploration of current news articles from the Japan Times/New York Times publications.
	Each lesson focuses on vocabulary, listening and reading comprehension to assist in discussion of a variety of topics, such as national/world events, politics, entertainment, sports, health and human-interest stories. Goals: 1. Vocabulary Expansion: Equip students with topic-specific vocabulary
	from each article for use in comprehension questions and discussions. 2. Reading Comprehension: Develop strategies to understand the main ideas, details, and context of newspaper articles.
Contents,	3. Critical Thinking: Foster analytical skills by discussing thoughts and opinions, and connecting articles to real-life experiences.

	5. Listening Skills: Improve active listening by analyzing audio versions of articles or related interviews.
	6. Engagement with Current Events: Increase awareness of global and local issues while practicing English.
	The class will be a safe, happy and supportive environment, where students are made to feel comfortable in expressing their thoughts and opinions, without fear of making mistakes.
	The aim of this course is not only to improve language skills, but also to encourage critical thinking and global awareness, making learning English both meaningful and enjoyable.
